Select (2) to four (4) people (youth-adult-seniors) to read selected portions of C.O.G.I.C. History (reference C.O.G.I.C. Bible) Add background music while history is read or dramatized. Have actors or readers dressed in older clothes dramatizing the historical scenes while history is read/with music in the background.

Download @ cogic.org 1 to 10 profiles of C.O.G.I.C Hero's of faith. Have young people act out the stories and dress the part of C.O.G.I.C. pioneers. Subjects might include but should not be limited to:

Who am I; I am a C.O.G.I.C. Hero of Faith; Did You Know?

Have testimonies from two (2) to three (3) people addressing questions such as; How the Ministry of Bishop C.H. Mason and the C.O.G.I.C. has impacted my life, family and ministry.

Have choir or a group sing a medley of songs from our past.

Allow young people to write and present speeches from selected subjects. See COGIC Heroes of Faith Profiles @ cogic.org and or the Centennial Bible.

Use the Sunday School Hour on Heritage Sunday to discuss COGIC History; (See COGIC Centennial Bible and COGIC Heroes of faith)
